



Dear Family, Friends and Loved Ones,

We are so happy to share that we continue to be **100% COVID-free!**

Based on guidance from CMS, CDC, and state and local health departments, **we will be ready to invite families to visit their loved ones starting on October 19<sup>th</sup>.**

Please be aware of the following strict visitation guidelines that we must follow to ensure the health and safety of your loved ones and our staff.

1. Visitation will be by appointment only; no walk-ins – **Call Leslie Parmelee at 540-674-4193 ext. 7108 schedule your appointment.**
2. Right now, visits will only take place outdoors, weather permitting (indoor visits will be available during inclement weather)
3. Visits will take place daily between 10am-12pm, 2pm-4pm, and 6pm-7pm
4. Each visit will last 15 minutes maximum
5. No more than 2 visitors per resident per visit
6. No children under the age of 13 are permitted to visit
7. Residents and visitors will be required to wear a mask that covers their nose and mouth
8. Residents and visitors will be required to maintain social distancing of 6 feet
9. Visitors will be screened prior to entry to check their temperature and identify any signs or symptoms of COVID-19
10. On the day of your scheduled visit, if your loved one is not feeling well, or they are on isolation, or their COVID status changes, your visit will need to be rescheduled; you can schedule a virtual visit instead by calling
11. This visit will take the place of your current window visit.

Our staff will monitor the visits to ensure these guidelines are followed. Visitors will be asked to leave if non-compliant.
